



Bayside Academy 2018 Summer Driver's Education Classes

Driver's education class will be offered in summer 2018. Participating students must be 15 years old and are required to have a driver's permit that they must bring to class. Students who are not 15 at this time will have another opportunity to take driver's education during Christmas break.

The cost for this course is \$400 per student. Each student who successfully completes the driver's education course earns a half-credit, which will be placed on the student's transcript.

The driver's education class schedule is as follows. Students are advised to sign up early since classes tend to fill quickly. Classes the week of June 4, 18 and 25 are limited to eight students. Class the week of June 11 is limited to four students.

June 4–8

June 11–15

June 18–22

June 25–29

Each class runs for one week, Monday through Friday. Friday includes both a written exam and a driving exam. During the week students will have 2.5 hours of written homework.

- On Monday morning, students will meet upstairs in the Bayside Athletic Building for classroom work to be followed by driving in the afternoon. Monday's class will last from 8:30 a.m. until 2 p.m.
- On Monday driving times will be determined for the remainder of the week, and students will learn their driving schedule for the week. Two driving times will be offered: There likely will be a morning and an afternoon driving time. After Monday's class, each student will experience two hours of driving per day for the remainder of the week.
- Monday afternoon and Tuesday through Friday will focus primarily on driving time as required by the course. Instructors will make every effort to accommodate each student by optimizing his/her driving time.
